Q&A on Support for Businesses

As restrictions are being eased, the National Cabinet is focusing on getting Australians back to work in COVID-safe workplaces and here are some questions that have arisen following their meeting today.

What can employers and small business owners do to get us all back to work safely?

How can my business help keep workers safe?

Information is available on how to maintain a COVID-safe work environment, for example by:

- cleaning the workplace regularly and thoroughly;
- restructuring the layout of the workplace to allow for physical distancing;
- allowing people to work from home where possible to limit numbers of in the workplace at one time;
- providing adequate washroom facilities, hand sanitizer and regular breaks.
